Dale Wannan founder of Sustainvest Asset Management has 15 years of wealth management and financial services. His advisory firm is focused on sustainable investing. He has a MBA from Presidio Graduate School His talk will be "Aligning Values with Dollars." The growing issue of sustainable and responsible investing.

Responsible investing came from the Embargo of South Africa in the 80's. It means that a stock or mutual fund must pass the test on green, impacts, and ethical management practices.

\$1.00 out of every invested \$6.00 now going in funds with these qualities.

1800's Quakers would not invest in slaves or war material companies.

1980 South Africa divestment and embargo strategies put pressure on ending apartheid.

1984 Bhopal, India where 8,000 died from air poisoning from a chemical plant.

1986 Chernobyl in Russia had the uranium plant melt down.

1989 was the oil incident of the Exxon Valdez in Alaska.

2000 Climate change issues.

The Sierra Club, Stanford, UC Berkeley, Harvard and other big foundation have gone this direction in the responsible foundation investing.

Companies are rated on their emission as a coal and gas company. They are further rated on Environmental, Social and Governance and lastly by executive compensation as compared as a ratio from the highest to lowest paid worker in that company.

Morningstar rates their mutual funds on ESG issues.

Not responsible investing are companies like Tesla and organic foods.

New funds are PAX, Domini, Parnassus, Ariel and Portfolio 21.
