Many thanks to Alec Peters for taking notes of the meeting.

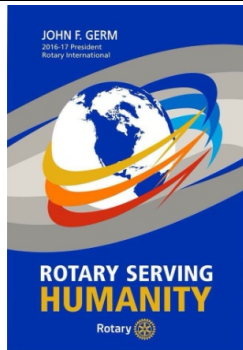
Club dues are due now and you may \$100.00 semi- annual or the full \$200.00 which covers you through June 30, 2017.
